

Clerk Report Full Council 19th November 2020

Barclays Bank Update

I am working with Cllr Long, Cllr Smythe and Cllr Graham to update the mandate. This involves removing Cllr Wells and adding Cllr Graham. The forms have been sent online. Unfortunately Cllr Long has had connection problems. I now need to speak to Barclays again and get the relevant forms sent in the post.

Update on the bench donated by David Bysouth

The costs of the licences were resolved at the last Full Council Meeting to be paid from CIL funds. The bench is currently being stored at Wealden District Councillor Bob Bowdler's property until we are ready to proceed. The licence form has been emailed to Highways, Bill Bentley and Bob Bowdler. I have emailed Jakk Country furniture for a quote for the bench installation. The CIL spreadsheet circulated show the costs of the licences.

The Bodle Street Green Gates

I have met with Councillor Velton so I know the location of each individual gate. The licence costs of the gates will have to be an item on the next CIL Agenda. If the costs are approved it will be a recommendation at the following Full Council meeting. I have sent an email to the Manager of the licencing department at Highways requesting permission for one licence for the three gates (agreed previously at a site meeting with Highways and Cllr Velton) and also one Section 171 licence Excavation of the Highway (not previously agreed) to avoid potentially having to pay for 6 separate licences. I am hoping to have these costs confirmed in time for the next CIL meeting.

Recognition for Service to the Community

There is no news regarding this item. It is in the hands of Wealden District Council to arrange. Tony Field's name was spelt incorrectly on the Wealden Alerts. I have informed Wealden and they will hopefully be correcting this error.
